## DIY charcuterie board workshops at NRG

“We keep selling out, and the feedback from the participants has been absolutely incredible” Botelho admits of the classes that have been running for the past few months. NRG has added the following class dates that will continue through the new year including: Saturday and Sunday Nov. 9 and 10 at 1 p.m., Friday, Nov. 22 and Dec. 6 at 6 p.m. and Saturday, Nov. 23 and Dec. 7 at 1 p.m.

“We also hold private classes with a six person minimum in which we collaborate the date,” Botelho explains.
